





In addition to his teaching he sponsored many student activities, one of which was the Student Council where he served as a sponsor from September, 1955 to June, 1960. 



The STUDENT IOWEGIAN is an organization for those especially interested in journalism and newspaper work. During the year, it was responsible for a page of school news and activities published weekly in the *Daily Iowegian*. Besides gaining the experience of working on a newspaper, members attend the Iowa High School Press Association Seminar in Ames every fall.

The Centerville Chapter of the NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY chooses members for academic achievement and qualities of character and service. Guest speakers presented programs several times; and members made a field trip to Iowa City, the Amana Colonies, and Herbert Hoover's birthplace. A special project included financing a permanent memorial to H. E. Fuller, long-time sponsor of this outstanding organization.

The main purpose of the LIBRARIANS' CLUB is to provide the twenty-seven student librarians with the fundamentals for proper operation of a library. Duties include checking books, assisting other students in the library, and keeping the books dusted.

SOCIAL SCIENCE CLUB, a new organization at CHS this year, accomplished a great deal. Besides appealing to those especially interested in the social sciences, the club offered an outlet to students with political enthusiasms. Special project was a field trip to the state legislature and Capitol at Des Moines.

Y-TEENS is a part of the Young Women's Christian Association and is dedicated to furthering the outreach of the Christian faith in all areas of living. The club conducted a panel discussion on moral standards, attended Foreign Student Day in Des Moines, raised money to help with toys for children in Peru, and put on a Christmas program at the County Home. Other activities sponsored by Y-Teens were also directed toward the organization's purpose.

The FHA's theme and purpose for the past year was "Action for Citizenship", highlighted by Senator Wilson's and Mr. Brees' talks on good citizenship before the club. A district convention in Moravia, a State Conference at Des Moines, the annual style show, and a senior honor picnic were also included in the year's activities. FHA helped sell concessions at the home basketball games and made draperies for the homemaking department as a special project.

FNA was set up to acquaint prospective nurses with nursing as a profession and courses necessary to meet their goal. Volunteers from the club gained experience through helping with health programs in the city such as heart-taping, immunization, and Easter Seals. Field trips included tours of several hospitals.

The local FTA is an affiliate of the National Education Association and the Iowa State Education Association. The Centerville chapter, at its monthly meetings, made studies of teaching and heard from professional educators. This spring, members traveled to the State College of Iowa, Cedar Falls, where they visited the faculty and campus. The VOCAL MUSIC Department took honors in contests and concerts. Music students in different choruses and ensembles performed at several school concerts, Prom, civic groups, Homecoming, Commencement, All-State, and State Contest.

FBLA's purpose is to create a better understanding of the business world. Activities included FBLA's all-school Dress Right Day, the state convention at Cedar Falls where local contestants placed highly, and an address by the President of AIB at Des Moines. Special funds were raised by selling pop and candy after school and at home football games.

The CADETTES had an active and prosperous year, representing Centerville at various events in the state. These were: "Steamboat Days" at Burlington, basketball games at Ames and Iowa City, Hot-Dog Day in Ottumwa, Pancake Day, the local flight breakfast, and local football and basketball games.

STUDENT COUNCIL worked on Homecoming, White Gifts for Christmas, the concessions at home basketball games, and the Awards Assembly. Some of the elected members also attended state convention at Ames in the fall and the district convention this spring. New officers were installed at the annual banquet in May.

Of great benefit in boosting the school's spirit, was the PEP CLUB's project to learn all new and old cheers for assemblies and games. In this way, members helped the Cheerleaders and encouraged other fans to yell. Pep Club also painted the signs and paper frames for home games, engineered the Homecoming Pep Rally, and sponsored the dance at the end of the basketball season.

FFA is another of several national organizations with a local CHS chapter. Its primary purpose is the development of agricultural leadership, co-operation, and citizenship. Some activities of the Centerville chapter included raising funds by selling popcorn at home football games, planting of a two and one-half acre corn-production plot, and assisting at the Appanoose County Fair.

In reality, there are several bands: MARCHING, PEP, and CONCERT BANDS. The highlight of the year came when the Concert Band performed outstandingly at the Midwest National Band Clinic in Chicago. Members once again took more I ratings than any other school at State Contest and in addition played at many school, civic, and out-of-town events.
